**82. MINUTES**

The Minutes of the Meeting held on the 1<sup>st</sup> March, 2010, as circulated, were confirmed and signed by the Chairman.

**83. WSCC : REVIEW OF WASTE DISPOSAL SITES**

The Committee noted the County Council's current re-appraisal of waste disposal sites in the County, a review which might conclude that there was a need to re-organise the operation of the present operation at the Burleigh Oaks Farm at Turners Hill and thus increase its capacity. Views on the current investigations were invited, and later in the year, towards the Winter, the County Council would consult again with those interested on any suggested changes in the operation of sites which were considered appropriate in the light of the information obtained via the current consultations. The Committee also noted that the Clerk was seeking further information from the County Council about the possible changes to be suggested in the operation of the Turners Hill facility, and that he would report further as soon as possible. The Council would then be able to comment on the known facts rather than possibly emotive opinions.
