<p><b>WP/12/01020/FUL</b> Wakehams Green Farm/Crawley Down Garage – Relocation of existing lawful long-term off-airport parking use and associated reception facility along with alterations to the existing access and landscaping works concerning land at Wakehams Green. The retention of an area of land laying beneath a 132k electricity line at Snow Hill for overspill long term off-airport parking purposes where the number of parked cars is to be limited to a maximum of 1,500. A change of use of the ground floor of the reception building at Snow Hill for storage purposes in connection with the existing data centre situated on the first floor of the same building along with associated staff car parking.</p>	<p>Objection. The proposed development at Wakehams Green would be contrary to Policies DP7 and DP 8 in the proposed new District Plan, and insufficient consideration has been given to the need for improvements to the access thereto and the effect on neighbouring roads should the development proceed.</p>
