30. MINUTES

The Minutes of the Meeting held on the 19th September, 2011, as circulated, were confirmed and signed by the Vice-Chairman.

31. CAR PARKING – CRAWLEY DOWN

The Committee was reminded of the need for additional off-street parking in Crawley Down, and it was reported that some funds therefor should be available as a result of the provision of the new development off Grange Road. In the circumstances it was suggested that some consideration should be given to the possibility of using for parking the area of land owned by the Council and lying between Auchinleck Court and Station Road. This site would accommodate some thirty cars, and could be surfaced with a material which would allow grass to grow through, thus softening the overall appearance of the area.

RESOLVED: That outline planning permission be sought for the use of the site as suggested, and that the matter then be further considered in the light of the result thereof.

32. AFFORDABLE HOUSES – LAND OFF HOPHURST LANE

It was reported that the Housing Association developing the site off Hophurst Lane had asked if the Council had any suggestions for the naming of two houses, which were part of the development and actually fronted Hophurst Lane.

RESOLVED: That it be suggested that the two houses be named “1 and 2 The Beckers”, with the rest of the development being known as “Beckers Field”.

33. PLANNING APPLICATIONS

RESOLVED: That the observations contained in the attached Schedule dated the 4th October, 2011, be conveyed to the District Council.
